The Lord called Moses and spoke to him from the tent of meeting, saying...









THE PIIKPIISE UP



OFFERING

A gift, literally "the thing brought near"

SACRIFICE

To kill an animal, specifically as an act of worship

THE PIRPOS OF SAGRIFICE

GENESIS 3:21 ESV And the LORD God made for Adam and for his wife garments of skins and clothed them.

THE PURPOSE DF SACRIFICE

GENESIS 4:3-4 ESV

In the course of time Cain brought to the LORD and offering of the fruit of the ground, ⁴ and Abel also brought of the firstborn of his flock and of their fat portions.

HEBREWS 9:22 ESV

Indeed, under the law almost everything is purified with blood, and without the shedding of blood there is no forgiveness of sins.

But now in Christ Jesus you who were once far off have been brought near by the blood of Christ.

EPHESIANS 2:13 ESV



HEBREWS 10:1-4 ESV

For since the law has but a shadow of the good things to come instead of the true form of these realities, **it can never**, by the same sacrifices that are continually offered every year, make perfect those who draw near.² Otherwise, would they not have ceased to be offered, since the worshipers, having once been cleansed, would no longer have any consciousness of sins? ³ But in these sacrifices there is a reminder of sins every year.⁴ For it is impossible for the blood of bulls and goats to take away sins.

11-14 ESV

And every priest stands daily at his service, offering repeatedly the same sacrifices, which can never take away sins.¹² But when Christ had offered for all time a single sacrifice for sins, he sat down at the right hand of God, ¹³ waiting from that time until his enemies should be made a footstool for his feet. ¹⁴ For by a single offering he has perfected for all time those who are being sanctified.



Therefore, brothers, since we have confidence to enter the holy places by the blood of Jesus, ²⁰ by the new and living way that he opened for us through the curtain, that is, through his flesh, ²¹ and since we have a great priest over the house of God, ²² let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, with our hearts sprinkled clean from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water.

1 JOHN 1:9-2:2 ESV

If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. ¹⁰ If we say we have not sinned, we make him a liar, and his word is not in us...

² My little children, I am writing these things to you so that you may not sin. But if anyone does sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous.² He is the propitiation for our sins, and not for ours only but also for the sins of the whole world.



I appeal to you therefore, brothers, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God, which is your spiritual worship.
