





CHARACTER

- The Spirit produces qualities like love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control (Galatians 5:22–23).
- These aren't self-generated; they are the Spirit's work in a surrendered life.
- Character is formed as believers “walk by the Spirit” (Galatians 5:16), allowing Him to govern their responses, emotions, and relationships.
