#### Observation

#### WHAT DO I SEE?

Ask six fundamental questions: Who? What? When? Where? Why? How?

#### **Notice keywords:**

important terms, people, places, or repeated words

Notice words that pull or push: commands, rebukes, exhortations, exaggerations, or promises

#### **Notice relationships:**

comparison/contrast, lists, cause/effect

#### Notice connecting words:

and, but, rather, if, then, that, so that, because, etc.

#### Interpretation

#### WHAT DOES THIS MEAN?

Based on your observations, ask a few questions:

- What does this mean?
- Why is it important?
- What does it imply?

#### Seek answers in the context:

- surrounding words, verses, and passages
- surrounding culture
- surrounding genre (story, poetry, law, wisdom, teaching, prophecy)

Seized and beaten by a mob in Jerusalem

Placed in custody of Roman soldiers

Put on trial before the Jewish Sanhedrin and High Priest

Survived an attempted ambush plot to kill him

Transferred to Caesarea under the protection of armed guards

Appeared before three Roman officials: Felix, Festus, Agrippa

Sent to Rome to appear before Caesar

Shipwrecked and snake bitten on the voyage to Rome

Imprisoned in Rome for two years
