FELLOWSHIP I MINUTE

We were saddened by the tragedy in Sutherland Springs, Texas, and other senseless acts of violence across our country. It’s difficult to stop every threat, but we want you to know that your safety is a high priority here at Fellowship, and precautions are in place to provide security each week.

Fellowship facilities are surveilled 24 hours-a-day by live-feed cameras, and a wall of video monitors are constantly observed for suspicious activity during services. Law enforcement officers, both plain-clothed and uniformed, provide professional security during worship gatherings. Over 30 trained Gate Keepers roam the campuses in Fayetteville and Rogers to identify potential threats. Protocols are in place for trained teachers and staff to respond to emergency situations, should they arise.

We hope this awareness gives you a sense of peace and security as you come to worship.
