GENESIS 4:8-10 ^{NIV}

"I don't know," he replied. "Am I my brother's keeper?"

for in the image of God
has God made mankind.”

GENESIS 22:6-8 ^{NIV}

Abraham took the wood for the burnt offering and placed it on his son **Isaac**, and he himself carried the **fire** and the **knife**. As the two of them went on together, ⁷ Isaac spoke up and said to his father Abraham, "Father?"

"Yes, my son?" Abraham replied.

"The fire and wood are here," Isaac said, "but **where is the lamb** for the burnt offering?"

⁸ Abraham answered, "**God himself will provide the lamb** for the burnt offering, my son." And the two of them went on together.

EXODUS 7:19 ^{ESV}
