










LUKE 1:1-4 ESV

 47 and my spirit rejoices in God my Savior,


 48 for he has looked on the humble estate of his servant. For behold, from now on all generations will call me blessed;



- he has filled the hungry with good things, and the rich he has sent away empty."






- as he spoke to our fathers, to Abraham and to his offspring forever."








GENESIS 12:2-3 ESV
