In Philippians 4:11-12 and 1 Timothy 6:6-8, Paul expounds briefly on contentment. The idea of being content in life brings me to a place of taking deep breaths of satisfaction and joy, which is where we should live. Recklessly and frantically pursuing life beneath the wings of His will is not how God intends for us to live! However, living in contentment does not mean we yield to complacency. Paul's life exemplified contentment, but never complacency. His life conveys intentionality and purposeful living. We most certainly find these characteristics in the life of Jesus, as well. As the Church of Jesus Christ, the same is true. We are to be content with God's provision, but never complacent, imagining that we've "done enough." No. No. Our Vision and Mission is fully activated until Jesus comes! As we grow deeper and reach higher, may we be known as a missional church, fulfilling His call for us – content, but never complacent.
