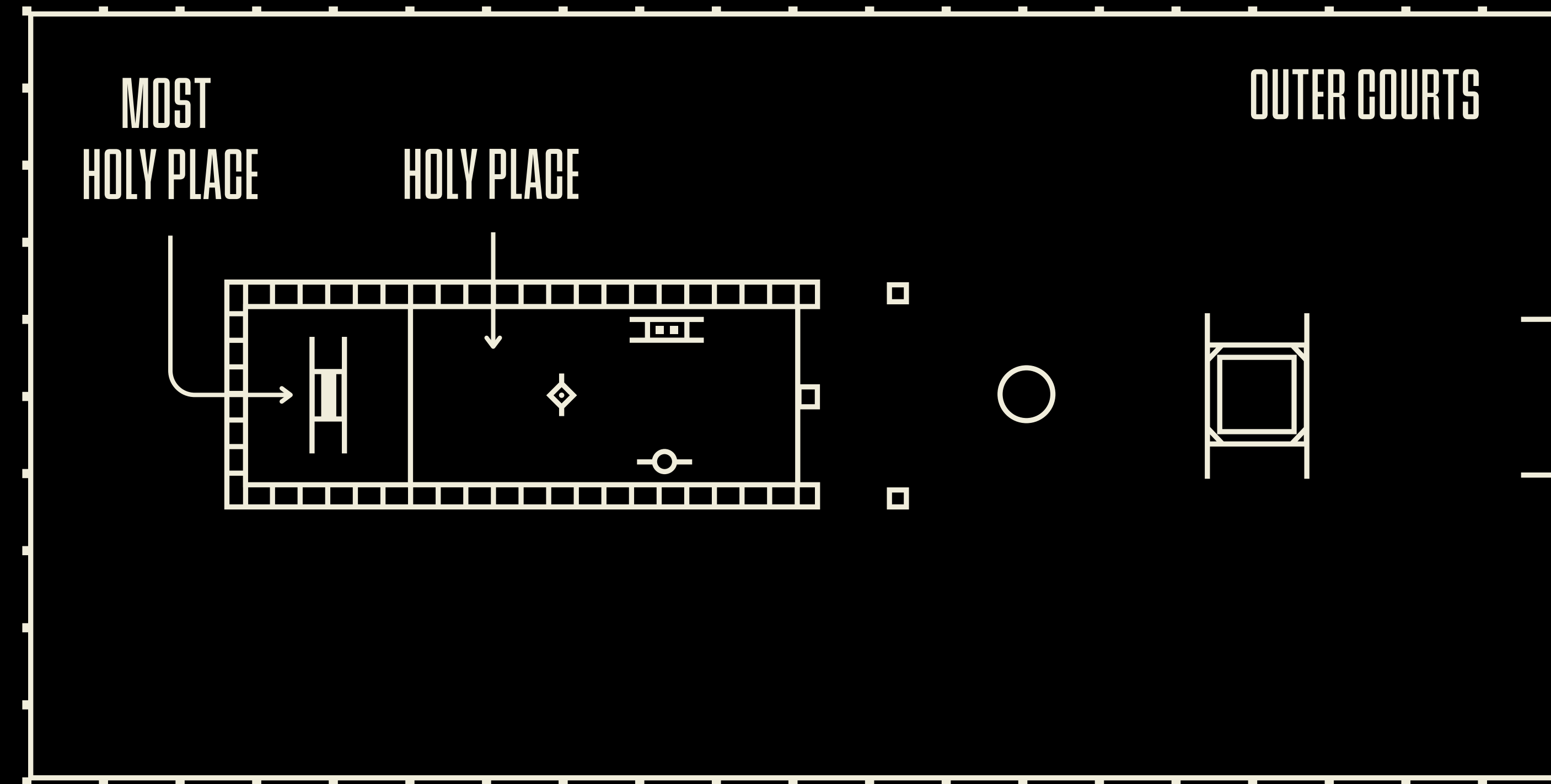
LEVITICUS 10:1–2 NIV

Aaron's sons Nadab and Abihu took their censers, put fire in them and added incense; and they **offered unauthorized fire before the Lord**, contrary to his command. ² So fire came out from the presence of the Lord and consumed them, and they died before the Lord.



LEVITICUS 10:10–11 ESV

You are to distinguish between the **holy** and the **common**, and between the **unclean** and the **clean**,¹¹ and you are to teach the people of Israel all the statutes that the Lord has spoken to them by Moses.

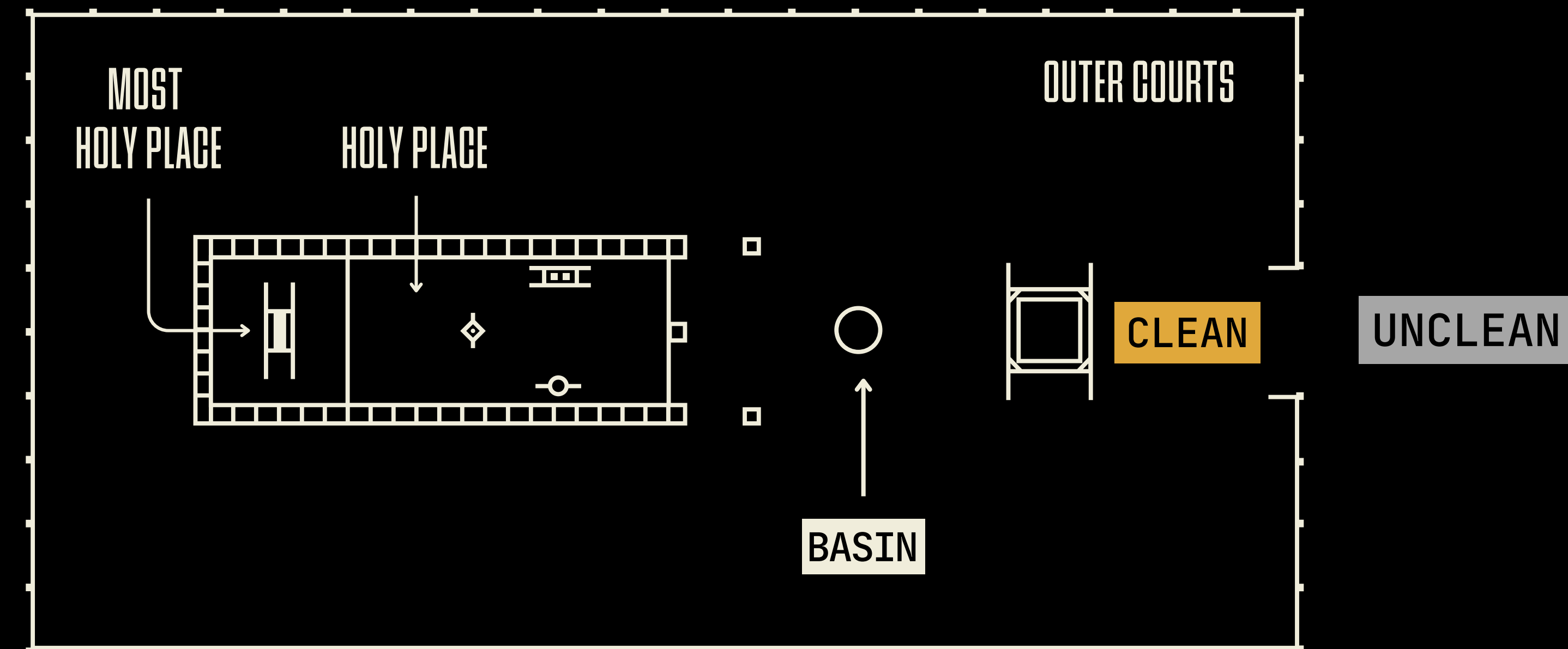
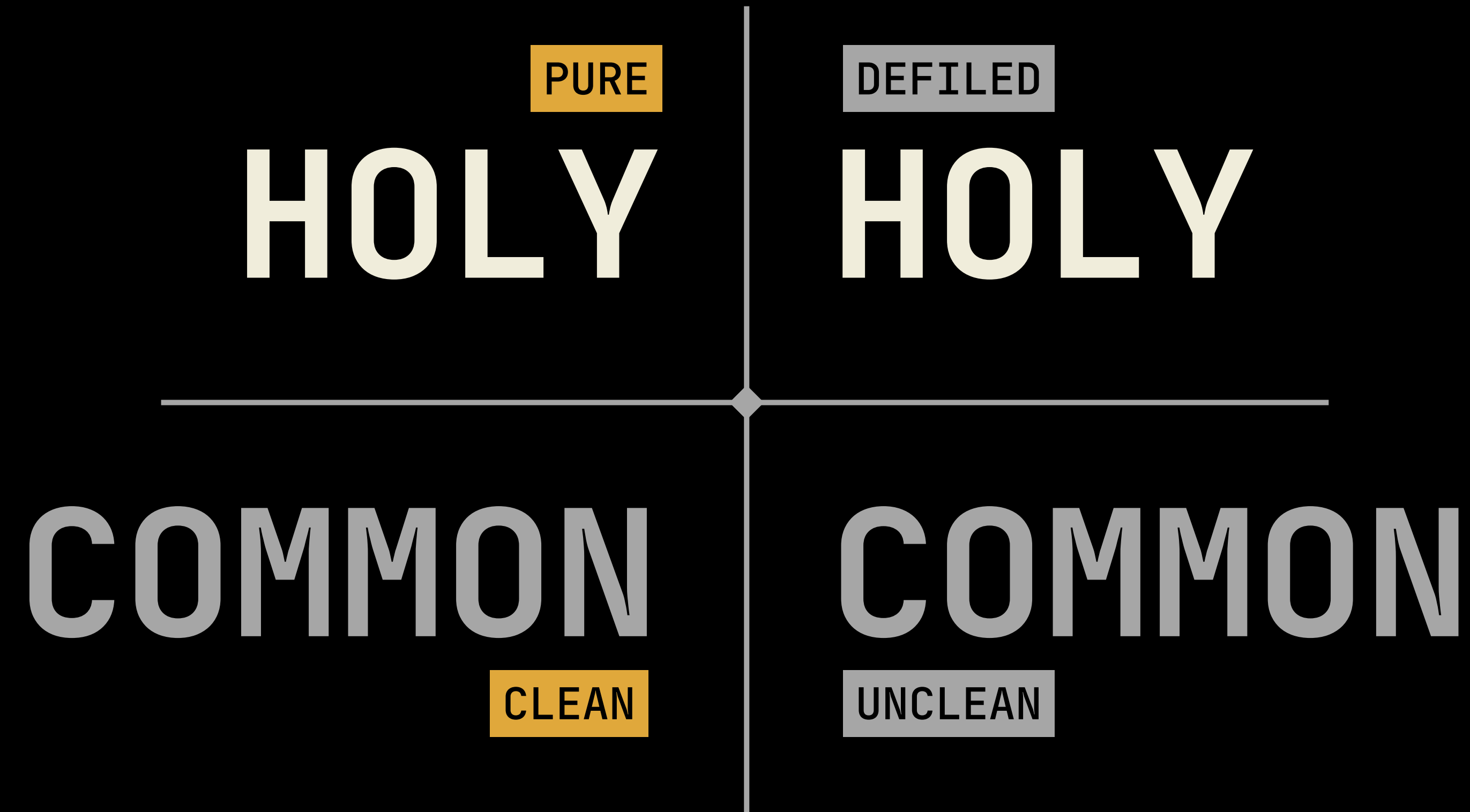

LEVITICUS 12:2–5 NIV

“Say to the Israelites: ‘**A woman** who becomes pregnant and **gives birth to a son will be ceremonially unclean for seven days...**³ On the eighth day the boy is to be circumcised.⁴ Then the woman must **wait thirty-three days** to be purified from her bleeding...⁵ If she gives birth to a **daughter**, for **two weeks** the woman will be unclean, as during her period. Then she must wait **sixty-six days** to be purified from her bleeding.’”

LEVITICUS 13:2–3 NIV

“When anyone has a swelling or a rash or a shiny **spot on their skin that may be a defiling skin disease**, they must be brought to Aaron the priest or to one of his sons who is a priest. ³ The priest is to examine the sore on the skin, and if the hair in the sore has turned white and the sore appears to be more than skin deep, it is a defiling skin disease. **When the priest examines that person, he shall pronounce them ceremonially unclean.**”

“When you enter the land of Canaan, which I am giving you as your possession, and I put a **spreading mold in a house** in that land, ³⁵ the owner of the house must go and **tell the priest**, ‘I have seen something that looks like a **defiling mold in my house.**’”

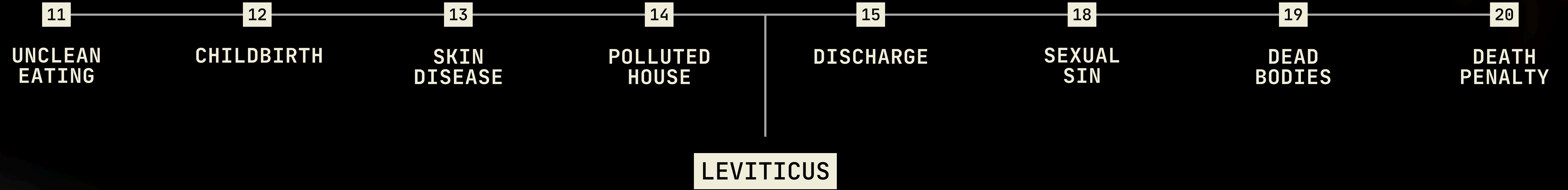
1 CORINTHIANS 6:9–11 NIV
