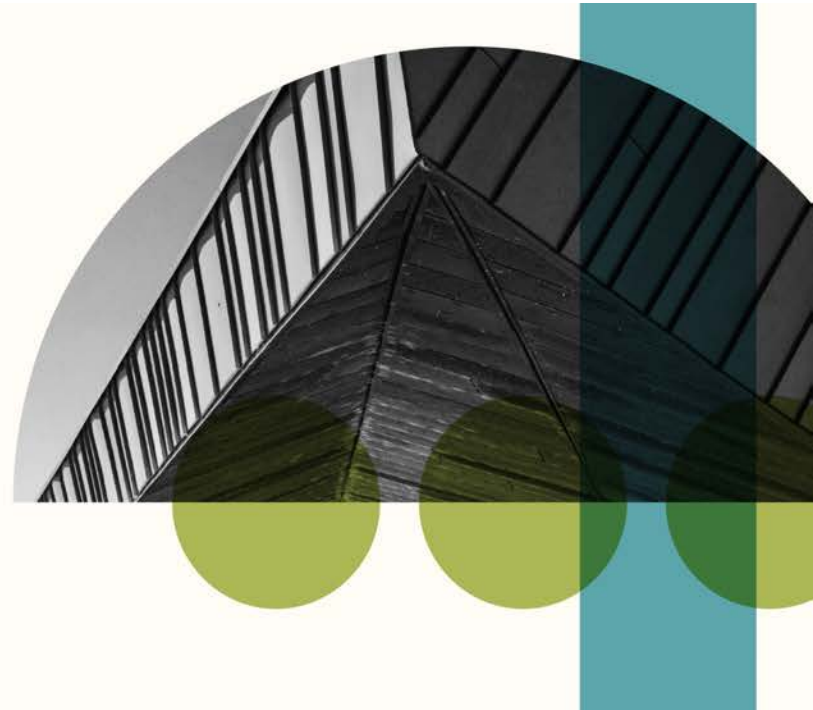
1 Corinthians 15:49 ^{ESV}

Just as we have borne the image of the man of dust, we shall also bear the image of the man of heaven.



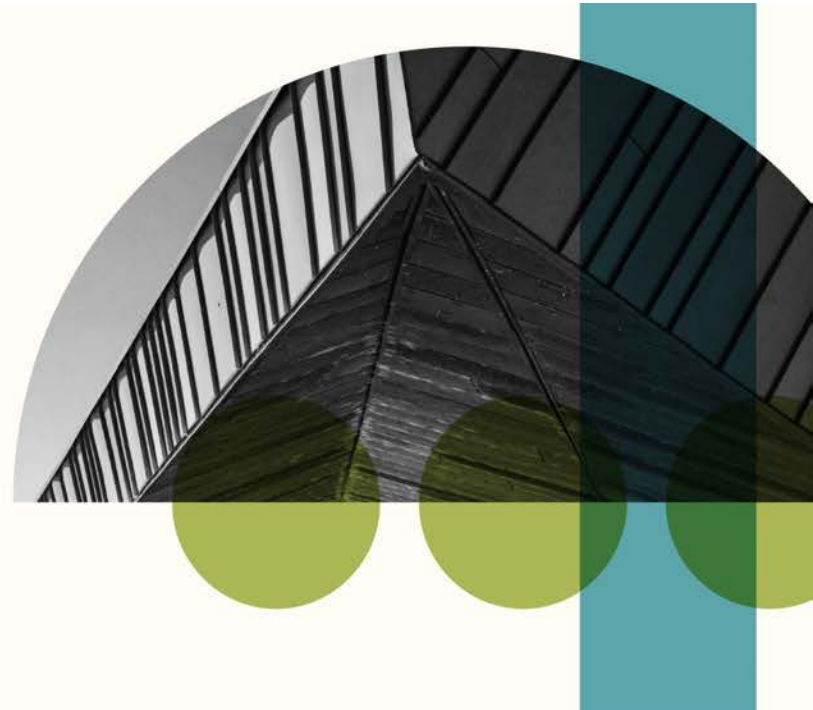
John 20:24-25 ^{ESV}

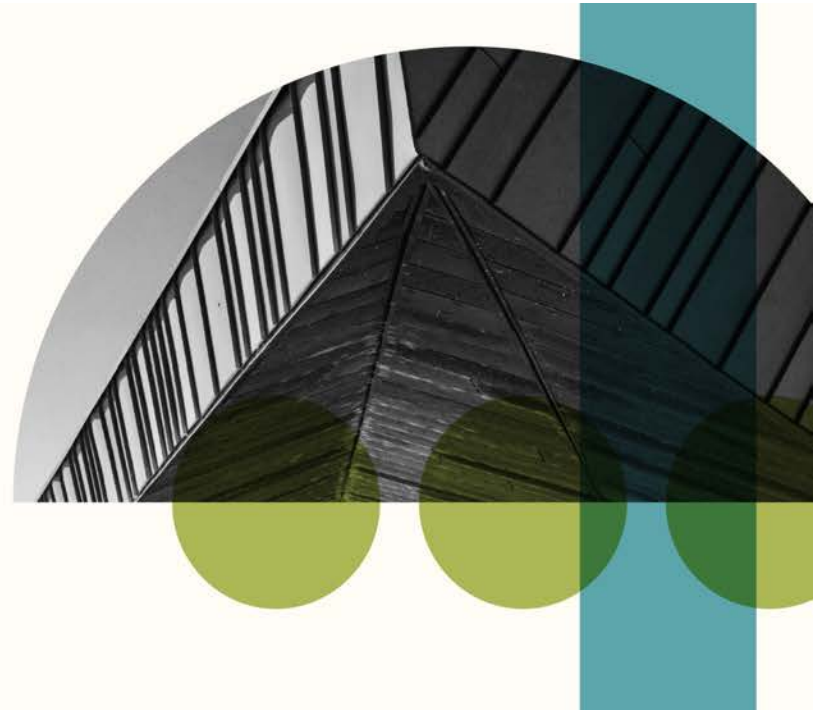
John 20:26 ^{ESV}

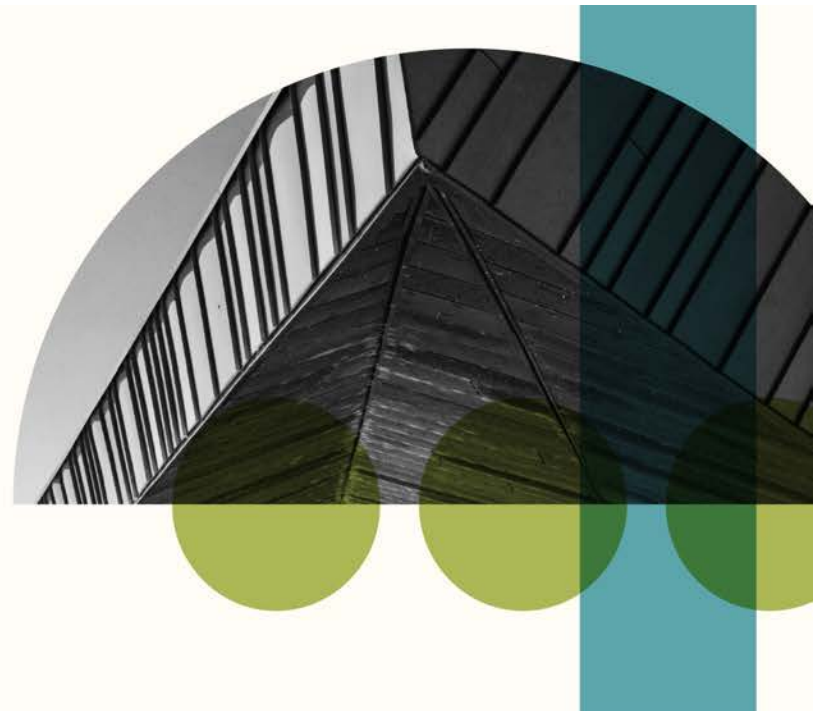


1 Corinthians 15:54-55 ^{ESV}
