Evangelism here is described as "Proclaiming the Excellencies of God." What do you find excellent about God? What WOWs you about Him? Describe a situation you have been in where you have seen THIS work...where simply talking about how excellent God is was the best possible course of action.

Live as SENT

The phrase "called you out of darkness and into His marvelous light" is important. It's an example of sharing your simple, yet life-changing story. As practice, write out a testimony that you can share in one minute that describes how you went from darkness to light. Be clear in what happened that made the change a hope-filled reality.

Close your time in prayer, specifically praying for one person to whom you are going to commit to share this story with THIS WEEK. Pray your eyes and ears will be attuned to the doors the Lord will open so that you can listen to their story and share your own.
