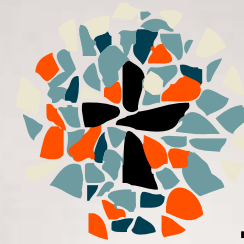

In Philippians 4:11-12 and 1 Timothy 6:6-8, Paul expounds briefly on contentment.
