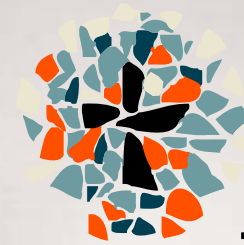

CONNECT with Pre-K and Kindergarten (Little Mo)

Ask: What was the name of the little girl in the story we heard this week?
