GENESIS 12:1–4 NIV

And the scripture was fulfilled that says, “Abraham believed God, and it was credited to him as righteousness,” and he was called God’s friend.



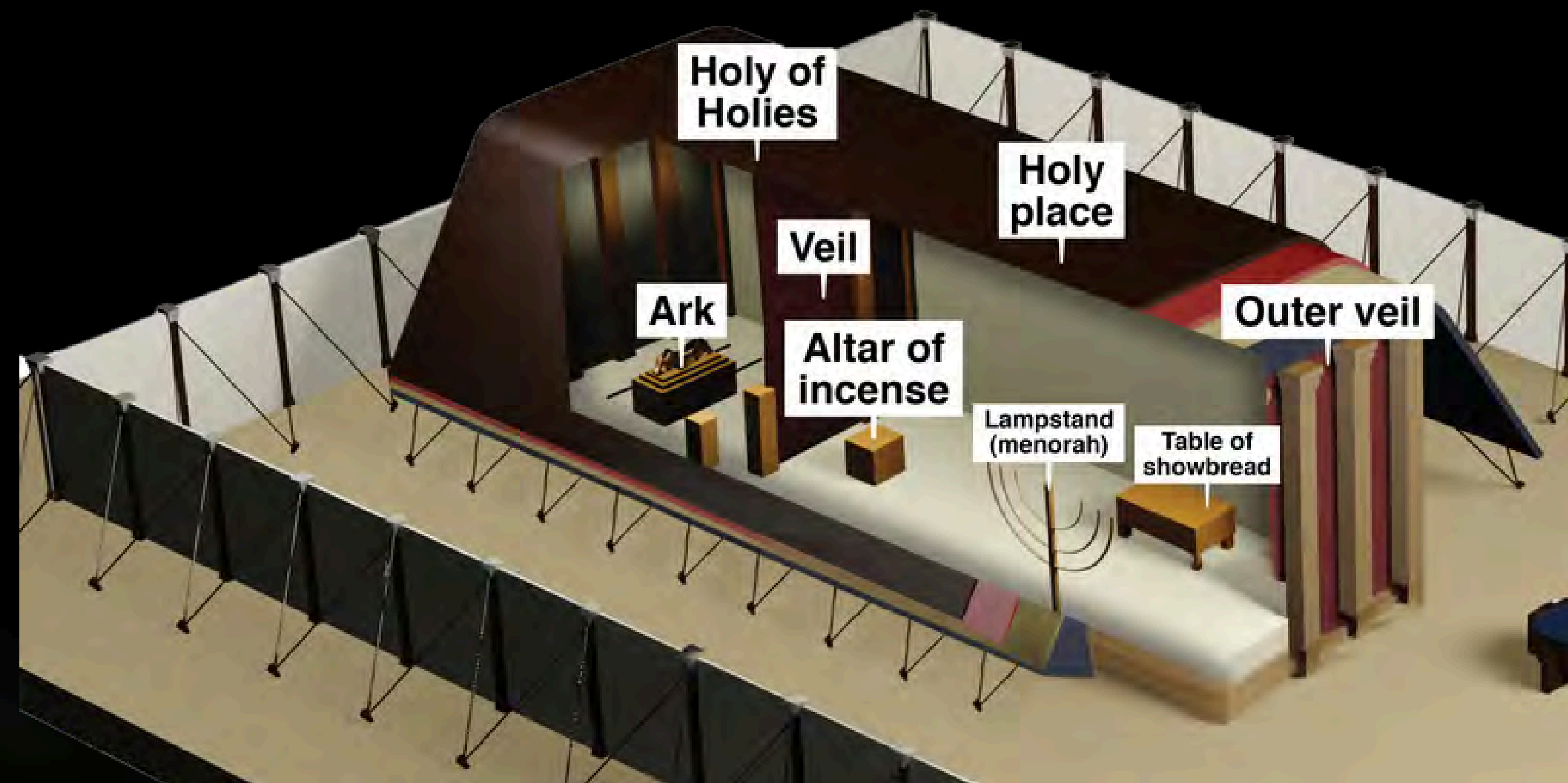

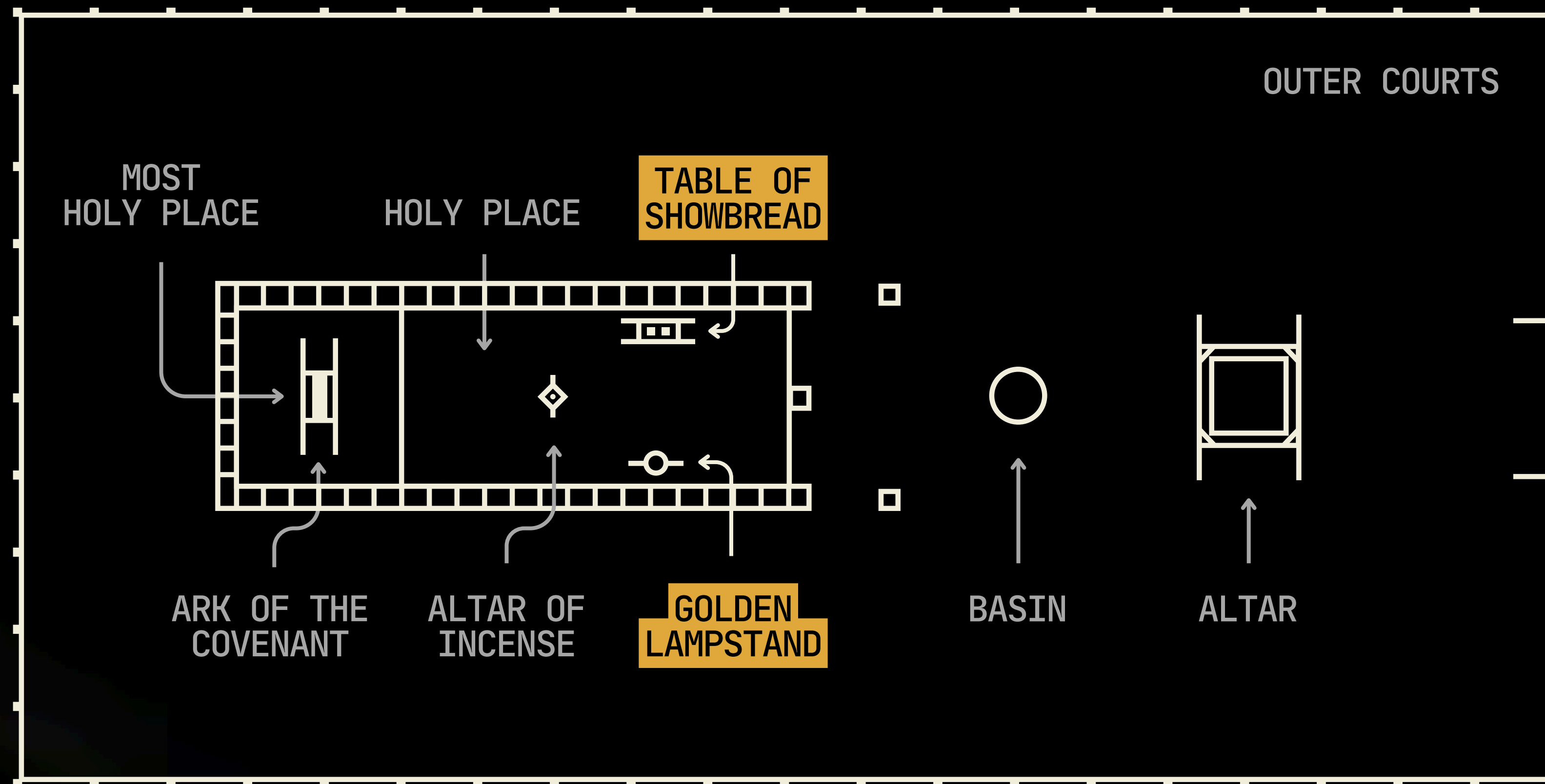

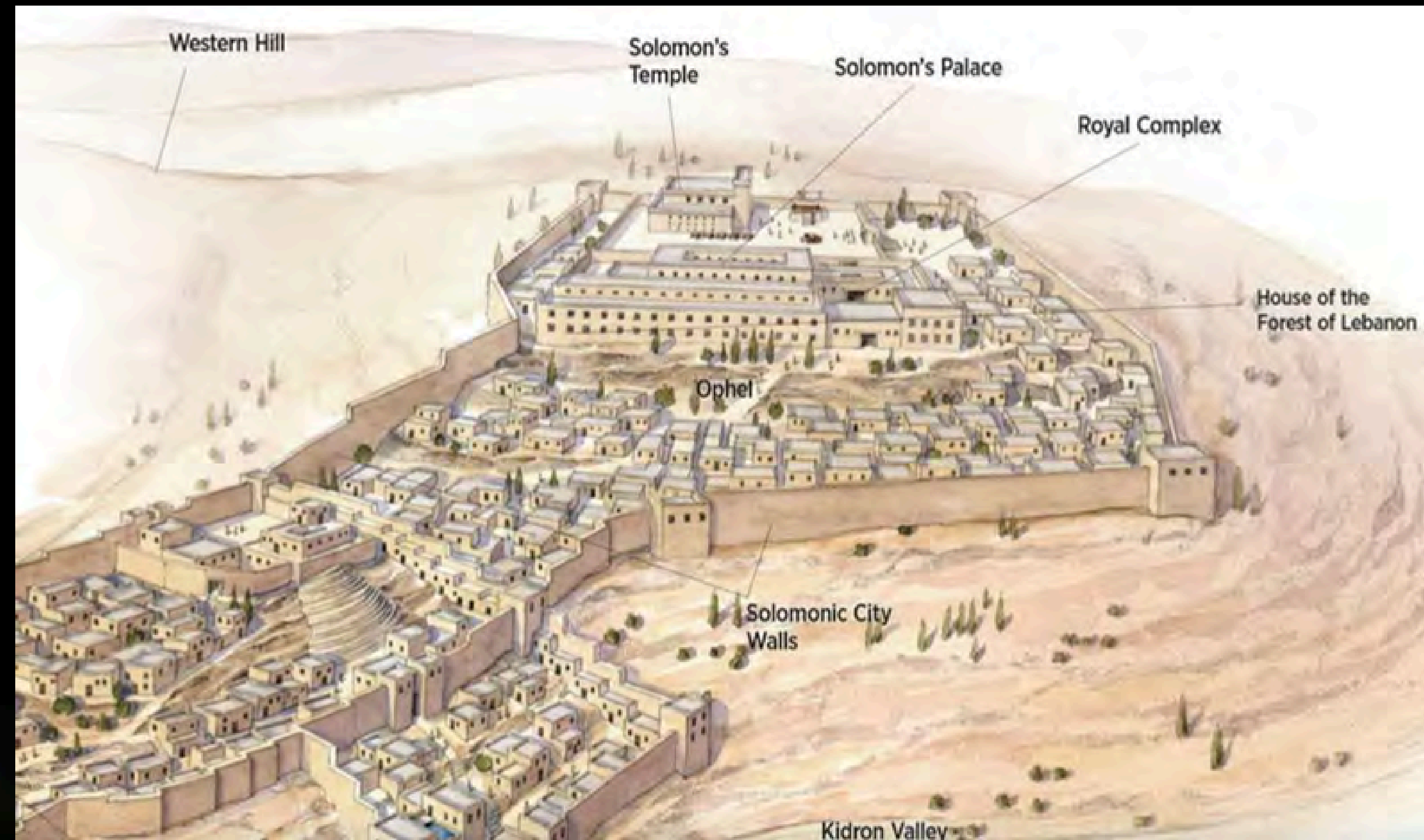


THE TABERNACLE

CIRCA 1450 BC



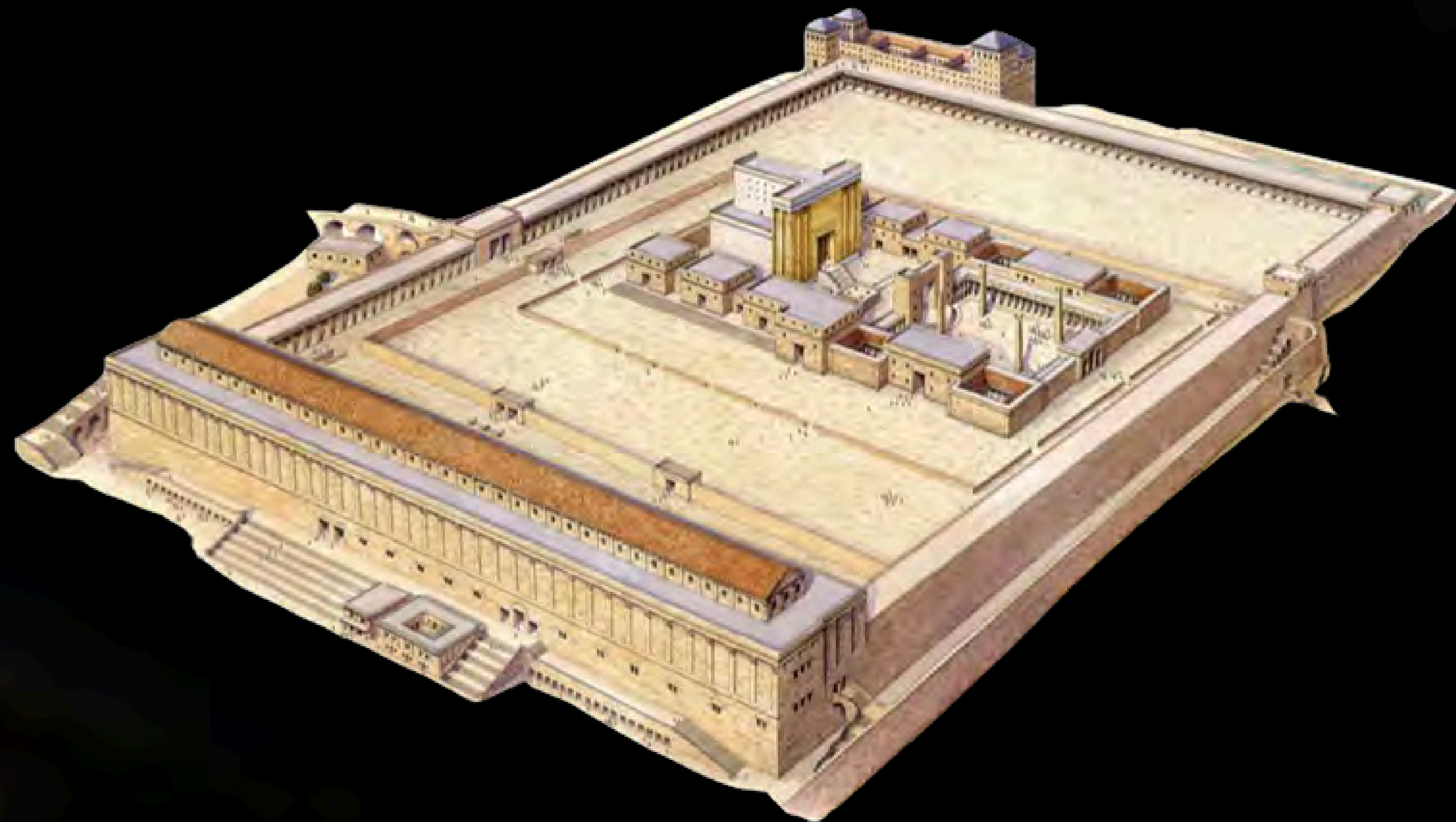




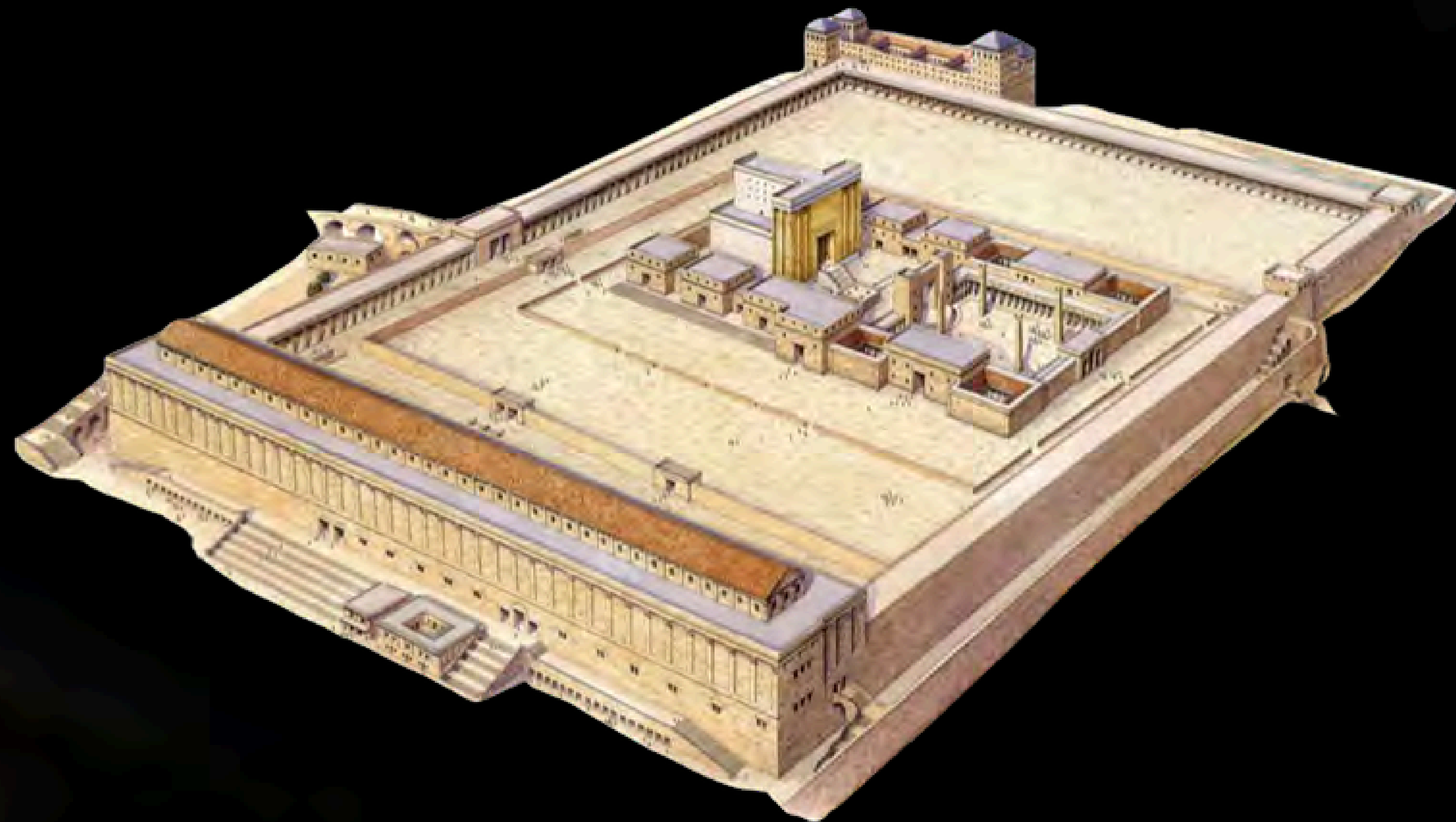


JEREMIAH 3:16 NIV

that God should repay them?”

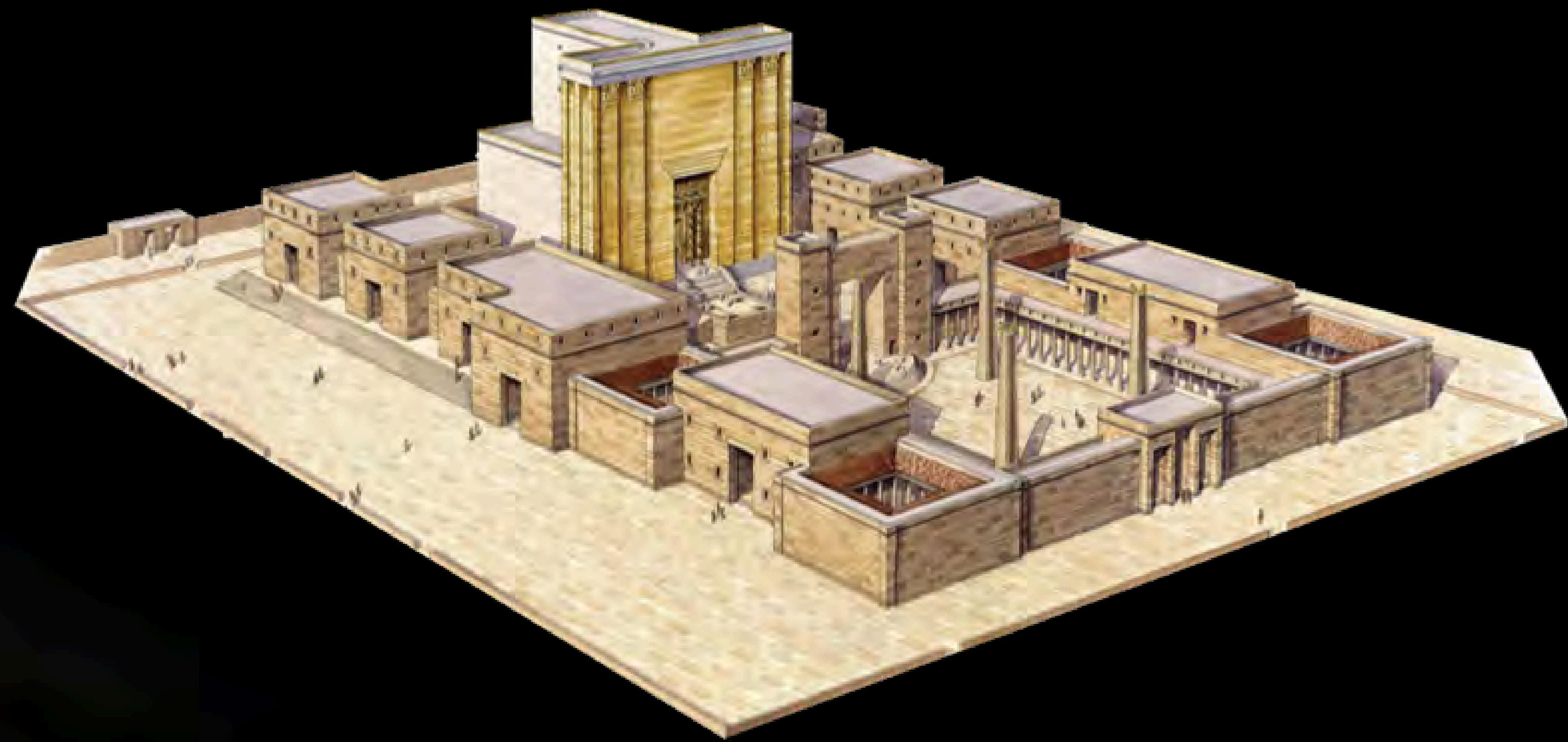

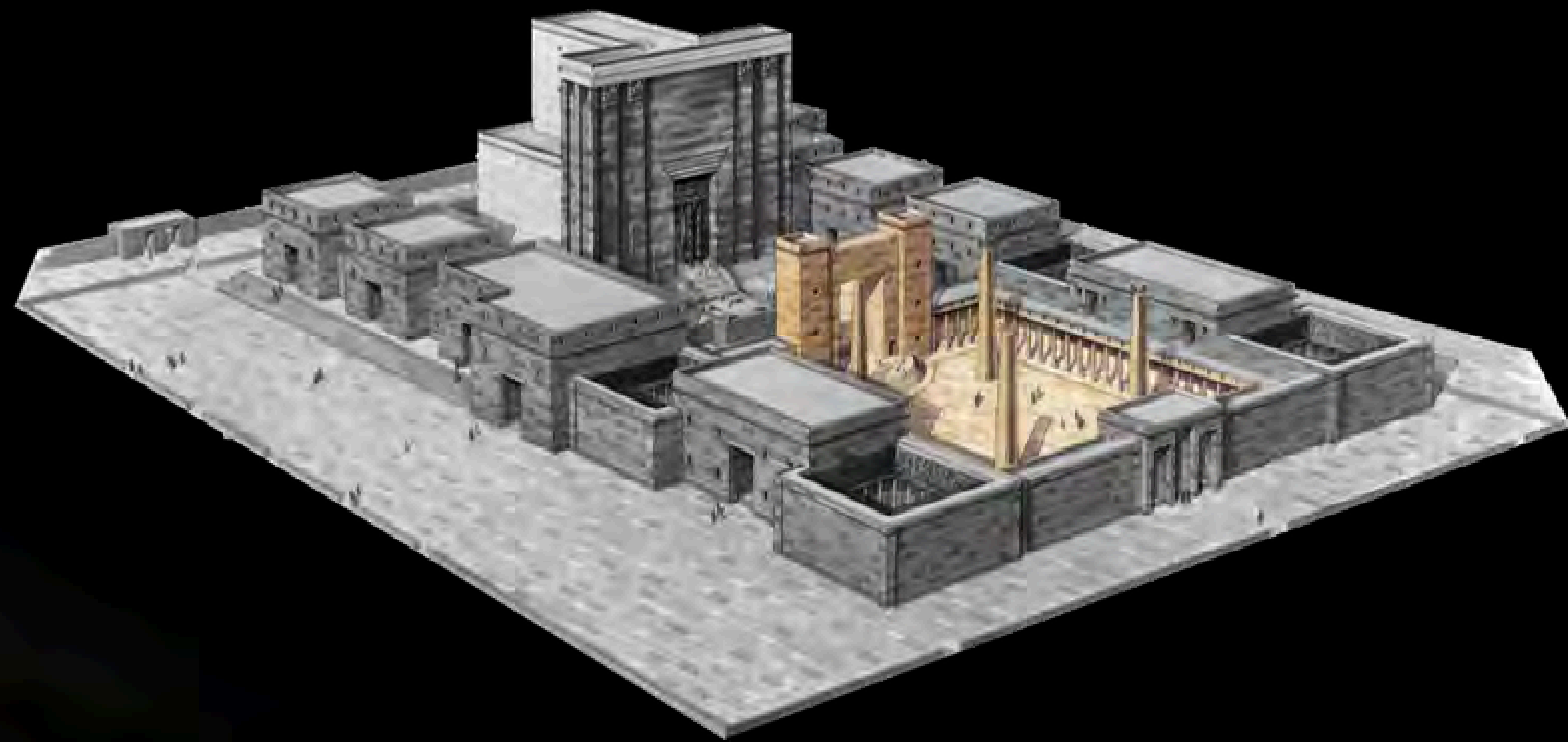

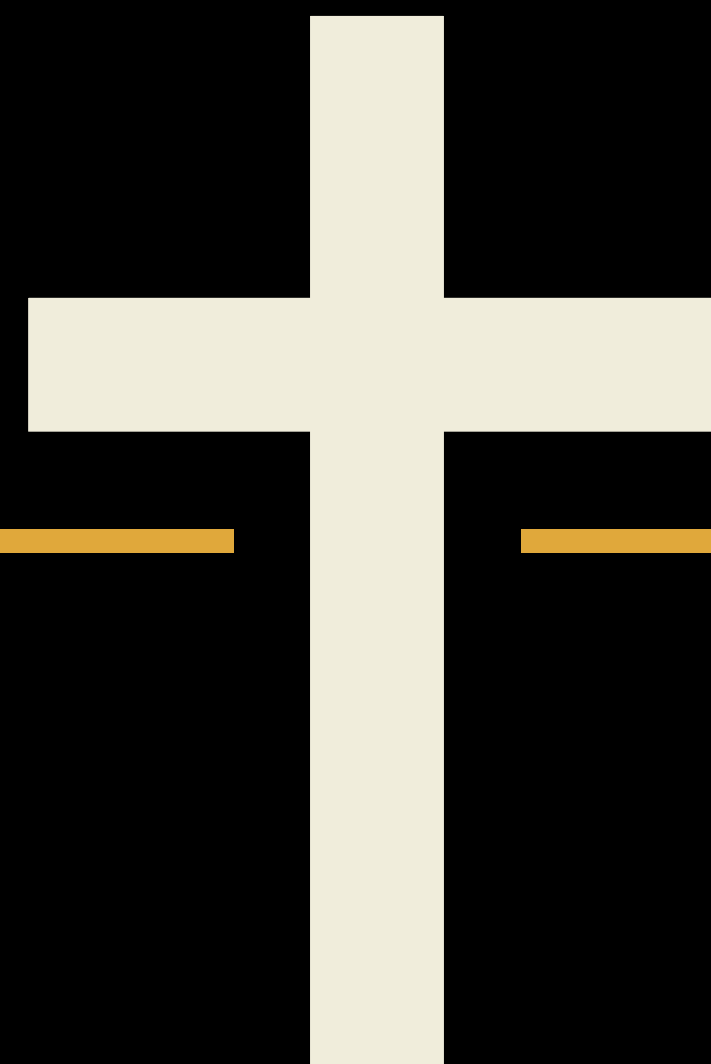
