What does it mean to say that God's love is "steadfast?" Share why that makes you thankful or what feelings emerge when you hope in God in this way.

Read Psalm 103:1-8.

What situation are you currently facing in life that needs God's love and mercy? How has God been faithful and loving in the past that offers you assurance He'll do the same tomorrow with whatever you are facing?

Read Psalm 51:1-7.

When you think about your life (as David is reflecting on his), compare your faithfulness with God's. Make a list of your sinful attributes in one column and a list of God's loving attributes in another.

Who in your life needs to feel the *hesed* love of God? Through a note, coffee, prayer, or meal, how can you bless your community in the spirit of passing on (in a small way) the steadfast love of God?
