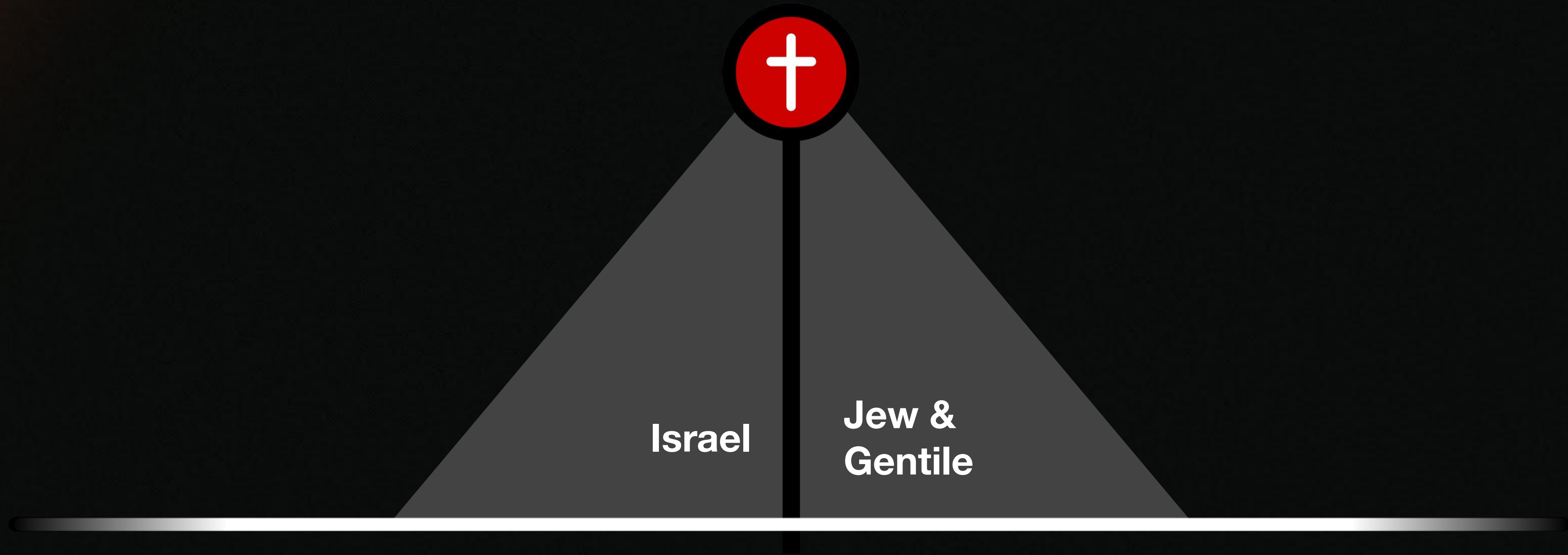




Ephesians 3:7-8 ^{ESV}
