What is the "stump of Jesse" referred to in 11:1? What would that mean to Isaiah's original readers? What does it mean to us?

Close your time together praying and thanking God for the wonderful things He has done (12:5). Use Isaiah 12 as a model for your prayers, or pray it back to the Lord in gratitude.

What does 11:2 tell us about the Hoy Spirit and His relationship to the Messiah?
