By the power of the Holy Spirit we draw near in this moment to be perfectly loved by You. And here in Your love, Christ, we are radically transformed, we are radically renewed.


Christ Jesus we eagerly await the day

The One for whom we were made




Until that day, send us out in all joy and childlikeness, sure of Your love and full of Your Spirit, to a world in desperate search of something real.

Jesus, King of Love, thank You for coming. You're changing everything.








#### Luke 2:6-7 NIV



whose origins are from of old, from ancient times."








#### Luke 2:15-16 NIV
