A NEW CREATION | Recovering True Beauty

Proverbs 31:10-31

What are some good memories you have of your mother (or another female who was important in your past)? Share with the group some of the fond things that come to mind when you think of her.

Read Proverbs 31:10-31.

In what ways do you see yourself approaching beauty from the world's standards and perspectives? How does this affect how you think of beauty, both for yourself internally and then in your spouse (or in a potential spouse if you are not married)?

We see that this list is not an impossible standard of how a godly woman always performs—no one can get up early and stay up at night. Instead, it's a recollection of how a wise woman has lived her life over the long haul. How does knowing this difference change how you read the passage?

What stands out to you about this list? What is surprising or noteworthy?

This proverb details what the wise life looks like in its entirety (starting with a wife, but it can be broadened to anyone who follows the Lord). In **31:30** we see the foundation for it. What does it look like to fear the Lord practically in your life? Remember, wisdom is about practical life "on the ground," so be practical in your answer.

True wisdom is ultimately only found in Jesus. Read **Matthew 11:28-30.** Consider the invitation of Jesus and respond to it in prayer for yourself, your spouse, and the others in your group.
