GROW

Read John 11:1-16 - the preparation.

What does verse 4 reveal about Jesus' perspective and purpose in this situation? Refer to what Jesus had told His disciples in John 5:20-21. What do verses 11-15 reveal about the circumstances for the disciples?

Why do you think Jesus might have delayed the departure for two days? How have you felt when God has not answered your prayers in the time frame that you felt was critical?

Read John 11:17-37 - the arrival of

Jesus. How does Martha's discussion with Jesus in this section reveal both faith and a lack of faith? When do you tend to do this – show signs of both faith and doubt? How does Jesus help increase her faith?

Read aloud Jesus' incredible "I am" statement in verses 25-26. How does Martha respond? What does Jesus' statement mean for us?

Read John 11:38-45 - the miracle.

Knowing that Jesus was about to resurrect Lazarus, why do you think He wept? How would Jesus' prayer and following actions help those present to believe in Him as the Son of God? (Note John's purpose for including this and other miracles in his gospel account in John 20:30-31.)

How can this story bring hope or encouragement after the loss of a loved one? How is death different if we know that there is eternal life at the end? How should life be different for those who believe?

What stands out most to you in this passage? What take-aways from this lesson can you apply in your life?
