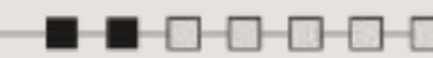

## *Purpose*

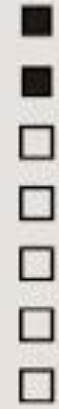
- To attest to the true identity of Jesus

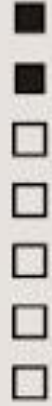

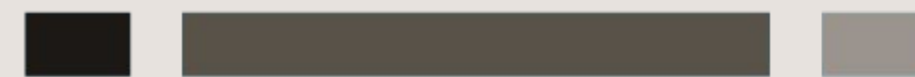

The father knew that was the hour when Jesus had said to him, “Your son will live.” And **he himself believed, and all his household.** <sup>54</sup> This was now the second sign that Jesus did when he had come from Judea to Galilee.

The man and his whole household believed

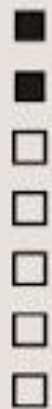
