Acts 2:42-47 niv

They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and to fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer. 43 Everyone was filled with awe at the many wonders and signs performed by the apostles. 44 All the believers were together and had everything in common. 45 They sold property and possessions to give to anyone who had need. 46 Every day they continued to meet together in the temple courts. They broke bread in their homes and ate together with glad and sincere hearts, 47 praising God and enjoying the favor of all the people. And the Lord added to their number daily those who were being saved.



Innumerable times a whole Christian community has broken down because it has sprung from a wish dream. The serious Christian, set down for the first time in a Christian community, is likely to bring with him a very definite idea of what Christian life together should be and to try to realize it. But God's grace speedily shatters such dreams... Every human wish dream that is injected into the Christian community is a hindrance to genuine community and must be banished if genuine community is to survive. He who loves his dream of a community more than the Christian community itself becomes a destroyer of the latter, even though his personal intentions may be ever so honest and earnest and sacrificial.

Community | Multiply

Elephants

- Elephants are fertile only 4 times per year, and carry 1 baby for 22 months per pregnancy, starting at 18 years of age.
- At 3 years, 2 elephants become 3, producing 26,000 lbs of food.
- In 5 years, 2 elephants become 4, producing 38,000 lbs of food.

Rabbits

- Rabbits are practically continuously fertile, and carry an average of 7 babies for 1 month per pregnancy, starting at 4 months of age.
- At 3 years, 2 rabbits become 50,643, producing 661,000 lbs of food.
- In 5 years, 2 rabbits become 69 million, producing 925 million lbs of food.
