From the Father In the Son **Through the Spirit**

Ephesians 1:13-14 ESV

In him you also, when you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation, and believed in him, were sealed with the promised Holy Spirit, ¹⁴ who is the guarantee of our inheritance until we acquire possession of it, to the praise of his glory.



Because of the past choice of the Father, I am His in Christ. (1:3-6) Because of the present riches of the Son, I have all I need in Christ. (1:7-12) Because of the future work of the Spirit, I will be like Christ fully. (1:13-14)
