

Intro: Spend some time today talking through giftings, ask your kids if they saw the Lord using anyone in the group, or if they recognized how He uses their giftings in everyday life.

Read Luke 10:2

- 1. What and Who is the harvest?
- 2. What makes the harvest plentiful? What does that mean for us that the harvest is plentiful?
- 3. Who are the laborers?
- 4. What does it mean to be a laborer? What does it mean to be one for Christ?

Read Matthew 28:16-20

- 1. Jesus proclaims His power, purpose and presence in the lives of believers, what does this mean for us today?
- 2. Knowing that truth, how does it change the way we live?
- 3. What holds you back from being a laborer for Christ? How can you use your gifts to work for the Lord and share Him with others?

Closing: Have your students think of someone in their lives that they want to love to Christ. Spend time praying for confidence and intentionality to be a laborer.
