In the sixth month of Elizabeth's pregnancy, God sent the angel Gabriel to Nazareth, a town in Galilee, ²⁷ to a virgin pledged to be married to a man named Joseph, a descendant of David. 

Matthew 1:20-21 NIV



Joseph's Response Matthew 1:24-25 NIV When Joseph woke up, he did what the angel of the Lord had commanded him and took Mary home as his wife. ²⁵ But he did not consummate their marriage until she gave birth to a son. And he gave him the name Jesus.

"I am the Lord's servant," Mary answered. "May your word to me be fulfilled." Then the angel left her."

Matthew 1:22-23 NIV
