

# His Death LUKE 23:26-56




When the days drew near for him to be taken up, he set his face to go to Jerusalem.


And as they led him away, they seized one **Simon of Cyrene**, who was coming in from the country, and laid on him the cross, to carry it behind Jesus.





And the people stood by, watching, but the rulers scoffed at him, saying, "He saved others; let him save himself, if he is the Christ of God, his Chosen One!"



The soldiers also mocked him, coming up and offering him sour wine <sup>37</sup> and saying, "If you are the King of the Jews, save yourself!"



And Jesus said, "Father, forgive them, for they know not what they do."



One of the criminals who were hanged railed at him, saying, "Are you not the Christ? Save yourself and us!"



And he said, "Jesus, remember me when you come into your kingdom."



### Jesus Rewarded


And he said to him, "Truly I say to you, today you will be with me in paradise."


Then Jesus, calling out with a loud voice, said, "Father, into your hands I commit my spirit!" And having said this he breathed his last.

Now when the centurion saw what had taken place, **he praised God**, saying, "Certainly this man was innocent!"


