




When Hope Gets Personal

JOHN 20:11-18


Now Mary stood outside the tomb crying. As she wept, she bent over to look into the tomb...

John 20:11 NIV





John 20:11b-13 NIV






When Jesus saw her weeping, and the Jews who had come along with her also weeping, he was deeply moved in spirit and troubled.

"Come and see, Lord," they replied.


35 Jesus wept.


Jesus said to her, "Mary." She turned toward him and cried out in Aramaic, "Rabboni!" (which means "Teacher").



When Mary reached the place where Jesus was and saw him, she fell at his feet and said, "Lord, if you had been here, my brother would not have died."





John 20:17 NIV


